

Supplies for 2024-2025 School Year

Kindergarten

- *2 Boxes- Crayola crayons
- *1 pack of Arrowhead pencil erasers
- *1 - 10 pack Crayola Classic Color Markers (washable)
- *12 or more glue sticks (Elmer's extra strength)
- *Large backpack without wheels
- *1 - 4 pack Expo markers thin or thick black + Eraser
- Change of clothes in a labeled zip bag
- *1 – highlighter set
- *1 box of large Ziplock bags
- *2 Dozen #2 Pencils – Dixon Ticonderoga - Sharpened
- Headphones to keep at school (must plug in & cover ears)**

Second Grade

Fourth Grade

- 4 Black sharpies – 2 extra Fine; 2 regular
- 2 Large glue sticks
- *1 dozen #2 pencils - Dixon Ticonderoga
- 1 pack Colored pencils
- 1 - 10 pack Crayola Markers- classic or skinny
- *EXPO dry erase fine point whiteboard markers
- 1 mini dry erase eraser
- 2 college ruled spiral ring notebooks
- 1 two-pocket folder
- Pencil box no larger than 10" x 6"
- 1 composition notebook (**no spiral please**)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 Pink Pearl Eraser
- 1 Highlighter
- 2 Red Correcting Pens
- Headphones to keep at school (must plug in & cover ears)**

Sixth Grade/Seventh Grade/Eighth Grade

- For Science: 2 composition notebooks and a pack of colored Pens or pencils; 2 - #2 Pencils
- For Math: 1 - 1½" 3-ring binder; Dry erase marker and Eraser (a rag works fine); Spiral notebook; **Scientific Calculator** (8th only, T1-34 Multiview); Ruler; 5 Dividers, Binder paper (college rule); Angle Ruler (Learning Advantage 7752); Compass; Protractor; 2 - #2 Pencils
- For English: 1 composition notebook, highlighters (variety of colors)
- For Bible: NIV Bible (We have NIV Bibles for purchase) 2 - #2 Pencils
- For History: 8th - 1 Spiral notebook (preferably perforated pages); College Ruled binder paper; 4 Pens (blue or black); 1 Highlighter
- For Spanish: 1 Spiral notebook; 1 – ½ inch 3-ring binder; Expo Marker and dry eraser; 2 - #2 Pencils
- For STEAM: 1 – ½" 3-ring binder; 2 - #2 Pencils Pencil sharpener; 1 pack of colored pencils; Pack of colored pens or thin markers; (8th grade only Architect Scale ruler)
- 1 Middle School Binder to be shared for multiple classes

First Grade

Third Grade

- 2 Pink Pearl erasers
- 3 large glue sticks
- 2 dozen #2 pencils – Dixon Ticonderoga
- 1 pack colored pencils
- 1 pack colored markers
- 1 - 4 pack Expo markers- NOT Red
- Small pencil pouch/bag
- 1 pencil sharpener- handheld that collects shavings
- 2 wide-ruled composition books – **no spiral**
- 1 - 1" binder
- 1 small pair of scissors
- Blue and Red Editing Pens
- 8.5 x 11 Inch White Dry Erase Board, with eraser/rag
- 12 inch ruler
- Wide Ruled binder paper
- Headphones to keep at school (must plug in & cover ears)**

Fifth Grade

- 1 dozen #2 pencils – Dixon Ticonderoga
- 1-2 Pink Pearl erasers
- 2 pocket folders
- 4 composition journals (75-100 sheet size)
- 2-3 correcting pens – NOT blue or black
- 2 – ½" hard cover binder
- 8 Expo markers
- Expo eraser or sock
- Pencil box no larger than 10" x 6"
- 1 - 12 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pack of 7 binder dividers
- 3 Large glue sticks
- 1 – 10 pack of colored markers
- 1 pencil pouch
- *4 Black extra fine sharpies
- *4 Black regular sharpies
- 1 – 4 pack of Highlighters
- 1 Spiral Notebook
- 1 pair of scissors
- College Ruled binder paper
